BOOKING NOTES

- Bookings may be made by either completing:
 - the on-line registration form at www.atlanticlanguage.ie/book;
 - a printed registration form, which may be downloaded from our website and then sent by fax or post to the address printed on the form.
- It is important to complete all necessary sections of the registration form.
- Group classes require a minimum booking of 2 weeks.
- The school will acknowledge all bookings within 2 working days and, where all necessary booking information is available, a proforma invoice will be issued.
- The proforma invoice is due for payment within 14 days to secure a place on the course.
- Atlantic Language Galway operates two school centres during the peak summer season. Students at each centre have access to the facilities at the other.
- Atlantic Language Galway reserves the right to transfer students between sites for operational and academic reasons, but in doing so, will endeavour to avoid unnecessary transfers while also endeavouring to ensure that students have access to an equivalent level of tuition and service.
- Booking requests for specific school centres cannot be guaranteed, particularly in peak periods.
- Atlantic Language Galway reserves the right to refuse bookings.

Class Size, Levels and Student Age

- The maximum class size for General English group classes is 12 students. The actual number of students will vary with an average in summer of 10 students and in winter of 7 students.
- Five levels are offered from Elementary to Advanced.
- Group courses: 1 lesson = 45 minutes.
- Private tuition: 1 lesson = 60 minutes.
- **Beginner courses can be taken as private tuition only.**
- **Please note that a student who tests at beginner level and is booked on a group course will be charged the full additional cost of private tuition.**
- General Business with English (GE1B), Standard General English Afternoons (GE1A), Discover Ireland West for the Over 50s (D50), Teacher Training (TRC) and Cambridge Examination Preparation (CEPxx) courses all require a minimum of 8 people to run. If this is not reached Agents will be informed at least 3 weeks in advance of course commencement and an alternative will be arranged.
- Cambridge Examination Preparation (CEPxx) courses will require a

- minimum entry level of English:
 - Standard courses (i.e. > 8 weeks)
Intermediate for FCE and Upper Intermediate for CAE.
 - Intensive courses (i.e. < 8 weeks)
Upper Intermediate for FCE and Advanced for CAE.
- General English with Business (GE1B) course requires a minimum entry level of English of Intermediate.
- The minimum age for students on adult courses is 18.

School Calendar 2010

- The school is open every Monday to Friday from 4 January to 17 December 2010 with the exception of the following Public Holidays:
 - 17 March; 2 April; 5 April; 3 May; 7 June; 2 August; and 25 October. Christmas Holidays are from 20 December 2010 to 2 January 2011, inclusive.
- Please note students will not be refunded for tuition missed due to Public Holidays.

Starting Dates

- General English, Intensive English, Combination and Private tuition start any Monday, or where necessary due to public holidays, Tuesday.
- Special Courses, including Cambridge Examination Preparation, Discovery and Teacher Training courses are offered on defined dates listed as given in the price list and on www.atlanticlanguage.com.
- In high season students who arrive mid-week to do their placement test may have to wait until the following Monday before being placed in class.
