Course Outline

Lecture Effectively in English will examine different lecturing styles and consider how to structure a lecture to encourage greater student engagement. Topics covered include the importance of signposting and pacing, using engaging visual aids and how to employ nonverbal communication. Throughout you will practice key elements of English grammar and vocabulary to enhance fluency

All courses are delivered at Atlantic Centre of Education in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast, and participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area. The week-long programme includes a full-day cultural tour to a local area of scenic and heritage value, a guided historical walking tour of Galway city, and afternoon social and cultural activities. - Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group.
