# Team Building Skills



Explore strategies for building more cohesive, inclusive, and productive teams in education.

# **Course Outline**

**Team Building Skills** is designed to help staff, particularly in educational contexts, develop the teamwork skills necessary to work more effectively and productively their departments and projects. The course examines topics such as team development, team roles, group dynamics, and conflict management, and considers the role of teamwork within diverse administrative structures. Participants also have the opportunity to share ideas and collaborate with fellow staff from around Europe, whilst enjoying Irish culture in one of Ireland's most vibrant cities.

All courses take place at the Atlantic Centre of Education in Galway, on Ireland's Wild Atlantic Way, offering participants the chance to explore Irish and local cultural heritage through a week-long programme that includes a full-day cultural tour, a guided walking tour of Galway city, and afternoon social and cultural activities, with staff available to recommend additional events and excursions.
